### Saints Athanasios the Great and Cyril, Patriarchs of Alexandria (Jan 18th)

In the half-century after the First Ecumenical Council held in Nicea in 325, if there was one man whom the heretical Arians feared and hated more intensely than any other, as being able to lay bare the whole error of their teaching, and to marshal, even from exile or hiding, the beleaguered forces of the Orthodox, it was Saint Athanasios the Great. He was born in Alexandria about the year 296. He received an excellent training in the sacred Scriptures, of which he shows an exceptional knowledge in his writings. Even as a young man he had a remarkable depth of theological understanding; he was only about twenty years old when he wrote his treatise "On the Incarnation." Saint Alexander, the Archbishop of Alexandria, brought him up in piety, ordained him his deacon, and after deposing Arius for his blasphemy against the Divinity of the Son of God, took Athanasios to the First Council in Nicea in 325. Saint Athanasios was to spend the remainder of his life laboring in defense of this Holy Council. In 326, before his death, Alexander appointed Athanasios his successor. Of his fifty-seven years as Patriarch, he had spent some seventeen in exiles. Shining from the height of his throne like a radiant evening star, and enlightening the Orthodox with the brilliance of his words for yet a little while, this much-suffering champion inclined toward the sunset of his life, and in the year 373 took his rest from his lengthy sufferings, but not before another luminary of the truth -- Basil the Great -- had risen in the East, being consecrated Archbishop of Caesarea in 370, who could continue the fight for Orthodoxy.

Just as St Athanasios fought against Arianism, St Cyril, also from Alexandria, fought against Nestorianism so we as a Church remember them together. We have a large icon of St Athanasios in our Church on the right hand side shrine. Take the time to appreciate the suffering and labors that these two men endured for our Orthodox Faith.

#### Ἅγιοι Αθανάσιος ὁ Μέγας καὶ Κύριλλος Πατριάρχες Αλεξανδρείας

Ο Μέγας Αθανάσιος γεννήθηκε το 295 μ.Χ. από φτωχούς αλλά ενάρετους γονεῖς, γεγονός που του στέρησε τη δυνατότητα για ανώτερες σπουδές. Ὁμως ὁ πανάγαθος Θεός τον προίκισε με πλούσια πνευματικά προσόντα. Λαμβάνει τὴ στοιχειώδη ἐκπαίδευση καὶ στη συνέχεια μελετᾷ μόνος του γιὰ νὰ φθάσει σὲ υψηλότερα ἐπίπεδα γνώσης καὶ σοφίας. Ἀπὸ πολὺ νέος ἔδειξε τὴν κλίση του πρὸς τὴν Ἐκκλησία. 25 ἐτῶν χειροτονεῖται διάκονος ἀπὸ τὸν πατριάρχη Αλεξανδρείας Ἀλέξανδρο, τὸν ὁποῖο ἀκολουθεῖ στὴν Α' Οἰκουμενικὴ Σύνοδο το 325 μ.Χ., στὴ Νίκαια τῆς Βιθυνίας. Ἀναδεικνύεται πρωτεργάτης στὴν καταδίκη τῆς αἰρετικῆς διδασκαλίας τοῦ Ἀρείου. Τὸ 328 μ.Χ. καὶ σὲ ἡλικία 33 ἐτῶν ἐκλέγεται πανηγυρικὰ πατριάρχης Αλεξανδρείας. Ἀπὸ τὴ θέση αὐτὴ ἀντιμετωπίζει ἓνα φοβερὸ πόλεμο ἐκ μέρους τῶν αἰρετικῶν οπαδῶν τοῦ Ἀρείου. Ὁμως ὁ ἅγιος, χάρις στὴν μεγάλη πνευματικότητά του καὶ τὴ ζέουσα πίστη στὸ Θεό, κατορθώνει νὰ βγεῖ νικητὴς ἀπ' ὅλες αὐτὲς τὶς δοκιμασίες ἀκόμη καὶ ἀπὸ τὶς πέντε ἐξορίες πού του ἐπιβλήθηκαν, καθὼς ὁ αυτοκράτορας Κωνσταντῖνος ὁ Β' ἦταν οπαδὸς τοῦ Ἀρειανισμοῦ. Ἐκοιμήθη ἐν εἰρήνῃ τὸ 373 μ.Χ.

Ὁ Ἅγιος Κύριλλος ἐζησε ἐπὶ βασιλείας Θεοδοσίου τοῦ Μικροῦ καὶ γεννήθηκε στὴν Αλεξάνδρεια τὸ 370 μ.Χ. ἀπὸ εὐποροὺς γονεῖς τῆς ἐλληνικῆς κοινωνίας τῆς πόλεως. Ἀνεψιὸς τοῦ ἀρχιεπισκόπου Αλεξανδρείας Θεοφίλου ὁ Κύριλλος, ἔλαβε μεγάλη θεολογικὴ μόρφωση, ὥστε ἐγίνε κατόπιν διάδοχος τοῦ θείου του, στὸν ἀρχιεπισκοπικὸ θρόνο Αλεξανδρείας. Ὅταν ἐγίνε ἡ Γ' Οἰκουμενικὴ Σύνοδος τὸ 431 μ.Χ. στὴν Ἐφεσο, ὁ Κύριλλος υπῆρξε πρόεδρος αὐτῆς καὶ συνετέλεσε νὰ γκρεμιστοῦν οἱ κακοδοξίες τοῦ δυσεβοῦς Νεστορίου, γιὰ τὸ πρόσωπο τῆς υπεραγίας Δεσποίνης ἡμῶν Θεοτόκου. Με πολλὰ πνευματικὰ κατορθώματα στὸ ἐνεργητικὸ του, ὁ Κύριλλος παρέδωσε εἰρηνικὰ τὸ πνεῦμα του στὸν Κύριο τὴν 27ῃ Ἰουνίου τοῦ 444 μ.Χ., ἀφοῦ πατριάρχευσε γιὰ 32 περίπου χρόνια. Δικαίως ὁ Ἅγιος Ἀναστάσιος ὁ Σιναΐτης τὸν προσονόμασε «σφραγίδα τῶν Πατέρων». Ἡ Ἐκκλησία θέλησε νὰ ἀδελφώσει τὴν μνήμη τῶν δύο Μεγάλων Πατέρων αὐτῆς καὶ Ἀρχιεπισκόπων Αλεξανδρείας, τοῦ Μεγάλου Αθανασίου, πρωταγωνιστὴ κατὰ τοῦ Ἀρειανισμοῦ, καὶ τοῦ ἁγίου Κυρίλλου, πρωταγωνιστὴ κατὰ τοῦ Νεστοριανισμοῦ καὶ ὅρισε τὸ συνεορτασμὸ τους στὶς 18 Ἰανουαρίου.

### Ἀπολυτίκιον

Τὸν συνάναρχον Λόγον Πατρὶ καὶ Πνεύματι, τὸν ἐκ Παρθένου τεχθέντα εἰς σωτηρίαν ἡμῶν, ἀνυμνήσωμεν πιστοὶ καὶ προσκυνήσωμεν, ὅτι ἠϋδόκησε σαρκί, ἀνελθεῖν ἐν τῷ Σταυρῷ, καὶ θάνατον ὑπομεῖναι, καὶ ἐγείραι τοὺς τεθνεώτας, ἐν τῇ ἐνδόξῳ Ἀναστάσει αὐτοῦ.

### Ἀπολυτίκιον τοῦ Ἀποστόλου

### Κοντάκιον

We commemorate the veneration of the holy Chains of the holy and glorious Apostle Peter.

### Apolytikion

Eternal with the Father and the Spirit is the Word, Who of a virgin was begotten for our salvation. As the faithful we both praise and worship Him, for in the flesh did He consent to ascend unto the Cross, and death did He endure, and He raised unto life the dead through His all glorious resurrection.

### Apolytikion of the Apostle

Without leaving Rome, you came to us, through the precious Chains that you wore, O President of the Apostles. As we venerate them in faith, we pray to you: By your intercessions with God, grant to us the great mercy.

### Kontakion of the Memorial

Remember, O Lord, as You are good, Your servant(s), and forgive every sin he (she, they) have committed in this life. For no one is sinless except You, Who have power to grant rest to those who have fallen asleep.

### Hymn of the Archangels (4<sup>th</sup> Mode)

Supreme Commanders of the Hosts of the Heavens, \* we, the unworthy, importune and beseech you \* that by your supplications ye encircle us \* in the shelter of the wings \* of your immaterial glory, \* guarding us who now fall down \* and cry to you with fervor: \* Deliver us from dangers of all kinds, \* as the Great Marshals of the heavenly hosts on high.

### Apolytikion of Great Martyr Catherine

Let us praise the all-lauded and noble bride of Christ, \* the godly Catherine, the guardian of Sinai and its defense, \* who is also our support and succor and our help; \* for with the Holy Spirit's sword \* she hath silenced brilliantly the clever among the godless; \* and being crowned as a Martyr, she now doth ask great mercy for us all.

### Kontakion (4th Mode)

You sanctified the virginal womb by Your birth, O Lord, and blessed the hands of Symeon fittingly, O Christ God; and even now You came and saved us. Now, give peace to our Nation in time of war, and empower our Leaders, so loved by You, the only one who loves humanity.

#### St. Paul's Letter to the Colossians 3:4-11

Brethren, when Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: fornication, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. On account of these the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. In these you once walked, when you lived in them. But now put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and foul talk from your mouth. Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old nature with its practices and have put on the new nature, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. Here there cannot be Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free man, but Christ is all, and in all.

Then said Jesus: "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" And he said to him: "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."

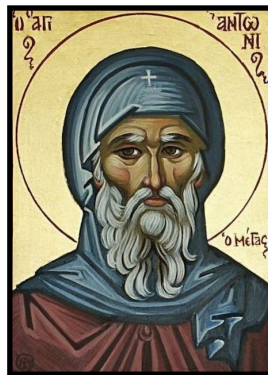
